


A Titanic Fundraising Evening





Storyline of Mystery Evening - "Transgressions on the Titanic"

It is 13thApril 1912 and RMS Titanic is three days into her maiden voyage from Southampton to New York.


John Anderson, a ship's engineer has gone missing; he was on watch in the engine room in the early hours of this morning 12-4 am and was logged out at 4:10 am in the log book.

It is now presumed that he has gone overboard, and we have a sinking feeling foul play is suspected. There is some evidence to suggest he may have been killed on board ship before being thrown overboard- traces of blood in the corridor, on deck and on the ships rails.
